COOKIE CUTTER LEAF MAGNETS

Leaf shaped cookie cutters
 Acrylic paint in red, yellow, green, orange and brown
 Paint brush
 Toothpick
 Acrylic spray sealer, matte
 1/2" round magnets
 Hot glue gun

Salt Dough Recipe (not edible)
 1/2 cup salt
 1 cup all purpose flour
 1/2 cup water

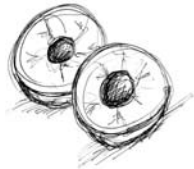
Preheat the oven to 250 degrees. Mix together the salt, flour, and water until a dough is formed. Knead the dough on a floured surface until the mixture is elastic and smooth. If dough is too sticky, sprinkle with flour; continue to do so until stickiness is gone. Do not add too much flour; this will dry out the dough and will cause it to crack before you get a chance to bake it.

Roll out the dough to about 1/4" thick with a rolling pin that has been dusted with flour. Use different sized cookie cutters to create as many shapes and sizes of leaves that you want. If desired, use the toothpick to draw lines in the leaves.

Place all leaves onto an ungreased cookie sheet and place into the preheated oven. Bake for 2 hours. Remove from oven and allow to cool completely. Paint with acrylic paints and spray finished leaves with acrylic sealer. Hot glue a round magnet to the back of each leaf and hang on the fridge!
