# SNOWMAN ON A STICK Make a buddy for your hot chocolate 

Hey, kids! Here's a fun and easy project to enjoy with your hot chocolate - snowman on a stick! Here's what you'll need:

- Mini Powdered Sugar Donuts
- Mike and Ike candy
- Fruit Roll-Ups
- Black Cake Decorating Gel
- Long Wooden Skewers

First, take 3 donuts and carefully slide them onto one of the long wooden skewers. Be sure the donuts are fresh or they may split. Next, take an orange Mike and Ike and push it into the top donut to make his nose. Then, take 2 more Mike and Ikes, cut them in half and push them into the other 2 donuts. They may be any color you choose. Now, cut a strip of fruit roll-up about 8 inches long and wrap it around the snowman between the first and second donuts. Cross over the 2 ends to make the scarf. Finally, take the black cake gel and make the eyes and mouth.
